Glad Monster, Sad Monster	Anne Miranda & Ed Emberley	fold out pages with different colored bears, each representing a different emotion
Too Loud Lily	Sofie Laguna & Kerry Argent	use with parents when talking about differences in children
The Chocolate Covered Cookie Tantrum	Deborah Blumenthal & Harvey Stevenson	use with parents when talking about discipline
Something Beautiful	Sharon Dennis Wyeth	use with adults to show how much you can understand about a book without actually reading it; shows how individuals can change things/make a difference
Koala Lou	Mem Fox	parent-child bond, love
Feet Are Not for Kicking	Elizabeth Verdick & Marieka Heinlen	
Love You Forever	Robert Munsch & Sheila Mc Graw	good book to start off parenting class with, shows how p-c relationship changes over time
Read to Me *	Judi Moreillon & Kyra Teis	shows the joy of reading time with rhyming verse
Leo the Late Bloomer	Robert Kraus	read with adults first, talk about how different children progress at different rates
