ELL 101: Understanding the Development of English Language Learners (ELLs) in the Early Childhood Classroom (ECE508)

Understanding the Development of English Language Learners in the Early Childhood Classroom is an online graduate credit course designed specifically for the Early Childhood Educator. The course is comprised of 5 sessions which take place during an 8-week period. Each session includes a number of readings along with an assignment. The readings cover the foundations of second language acquisition along with the social and cultural adaptation of the English Language Learner in the early childhood classroom.

THIS COURSE WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR A BILINGUAL OR ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE APPROVAL OR ENDORSEMENT. AS THIS COURSE IS ONLINE, THERE WILL BE NO FACE-TO-FACE CLASSROOM ATTENDANCE. ALL CLASSROOM REQUIREMENTS WILL BE FULFILLED THROUGH DISCUSSIONS, ASSIGNMENTS, AND EVALUATIONS VIA THE INTERNET. WHILE THIS FORMAT ALLOWS FOR GREAT FLEXIBILITY, STUDENTS CHOOSING TO STUDY ONLINE SHOULD HAVE EXCELLENT COMPUTER SKILLS AND BE PREPARED TO INTERACT REGULARLY WITH OTHERS USING TECHNOLOGY.

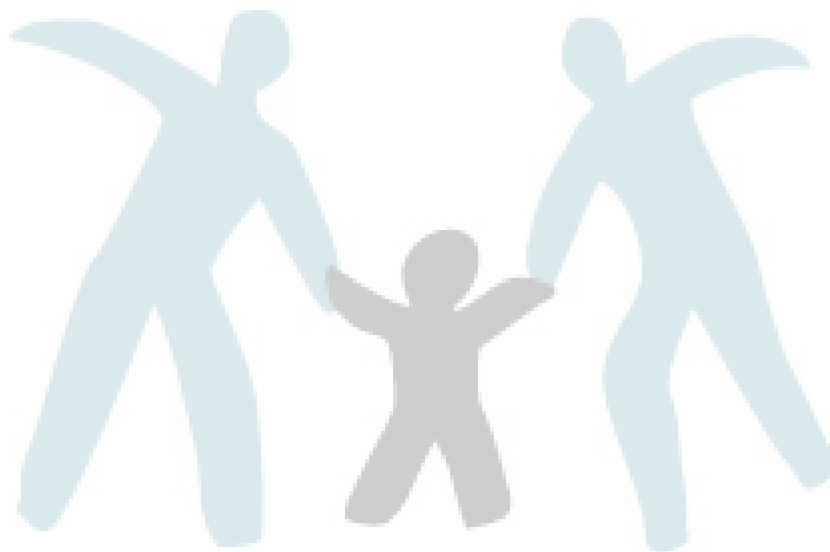

General Information

The Early Childhood project, in partnership with National-Louis University will be offering graduate credit for this course.

FORMAT: Online (requires computer access to the Internet)

COST: \$250.00 for 1 graduate credit hour

TEXTBOOKS: Students are responsible for purchasing their own textbook(s). Students will receive a registration confirmation letter three weeks prior to the first class session, which will specify which book(s) to purchase.

NOTE: This course assumes some prior experience using internet tools.

Early Childhood Registration and Payment Policy

Registration deadline is 4 weeks prior to the starting date of each course based on space availability. Due to the nature of the course being taught online, space is limited.

Registration will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis with priority being given to those individuals serving in state funded Preschool for All programs. **If you have missed the deadline for registration, you must** call Early Childhood prior to mailing a registration form to ensure space is available. Please note that once you attempt to register either through the mail or online, your payment will be automatically processed. If in the event that a course is closed or cancelled due to low enrollment and your payment has been processed, you will be refunded the full amount within 30 days.

Registration for course must be accompanied with full payment of \$250.00 (in the form of check or credit card). **Tuition is non-refundable after the first session.** In the event that you cancel during the first session, a \$25.00 cancellation fee will be deducted from your tuition refund.

Online registration is available. We encourage you to register online, if you plan to pay using a credit card.
